

## SEVIER COUNTY PARTNERS IN PROGRESS HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT PARTNERS IN PROGRESS SCHOLARSHIP, A STUDENT MUST:

1. Be a resident of Sevier County and be enrolled in a Sevier County high school for a minimum of twelve (12) months prior to making application for the scholarship.
2. Meet dual enrollment requirements as outlined for the Sevier County School System.
3. Have completed all of the academic requirements of the 10<sup>th</sup> grade and be classified as an 11<sup>th</sup> grader (high school junior), completed and submitted the Dual Enrollment Grant application. Dual Enrollment classes 1 & 2 are covered under the Dual Enrollment Grant from the State of Tennessee.
4. Have a high school GPA of 3.0 + (letter grade of B) or an ACT composite of 21 to be eligible to take dual enrollment classes.
5. Students enrolling in English composition sequence or in a college level mathematics course must have appropriate placement levels as administered by the Office of Enrollment Services at Walters State Community college.
6. Students that are currently recognized as juniors and have completed Dual Enrollment Classes 1 & 2 are eligible to apply for the PIP scholarship (\$100 for Class 3 and \$250 for Class 4 – not to exceed \$350 for classes 3 & 4). A student must first apply for all other scholarship and financial aid programs available (Dual Enrollment grant and Sevier County Schools grant).

7. PIP scholarships of \$100 per class will be available to students that have completed 4 dual enrollment classes. (Limit: PIP will pay set amounts for classes 3-8).

8. Once a student begins taking dual enrollment classes, they must maintain a college GPA of 3.0 or higher to continue to receive Partners In Progress funds for dual enrollment classes. If a student loses the Dual Enrollment Grant, they are not eligible for the Partners in Progress scholarship.

**STUDENTS INTERESTED IN APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM MUST:**

9. The Sevier County Schools grant is only for classes taken on high school campuses not for classes taken at WSCC campus. ***However, the Partners in Progress grant also applies to dual enrollment classes taken at the Walters State campus in Sevierville.***
